COURSE DESCRIPTION

"Whoever Allah wishes good for, He gives them a deep understanding [fiqh] of their Deen." - Bukhari

In this course the students will learn the laws of purification, prayer, fasting, charity and pilgrimage based on a classical primer in the Hanafi madhhab. They will also explore the spiritual dimensions of these acts of worship.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

- 1. To learn what Islamic law is all about in general, and the figh of the Ḥanafī school in particular
- 2. To appreciate the complexity and precision of Islamic law, and the meticulousness of our scholars
- 3. To admit our own ignorance, and the need for learning
- 4. To understand the difference between legal validity and divine acceptance
- 5. To appreciate the incredible benefits and spiritual secrets of the acts of worship
- 6. To cultivate a desire to improve the quality of our worship
