COURSE DESCRIPTION

"Whoever Allah wishes good for, He gives them a deep understanding [*fiqh*] of their *Deen*." – Bukhari

In this course the students will learn the legal rulings pertaining to purification, prayer, fasting, charity and pilgrimage based on a classical primer in the Hanafi madhhab.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

- 1. To learn what Islamic law is all about in general, and the fiqh of the school of Imām Hanafi in particular
- 2. To appreciate the complexity and precision of Islamic law, and the meticulousness of our scholars
- 3. To admit our own ignorance, and the need for learning
- 4. To understand the difference between legal validity and divine acceptance
- 5. To cultivate a desire to improve the quality of our worship
