Imam Mohamed Al-Gebaly graduated from al-Azhar University in 1996. He is an instructor at Mishkah University. He also serves as a Mufti for the Fatwa Hotline of the Assembly of Muslim Jurists of America (AMJA), and the Imam at the Salahadeen Islamic Center in Plano, TX.



Imam Sajid Ali initiated his formal Islamic studies at the Institute of Islamic Education in Elgin, Illinois. After completing his 'Alim course, he briefly pursued higher secular education before his zeal for jurisprudence led him to Camperdown, South Africa, where he enrolled at Madrasah In'aamiyyah to specialize in the field of issuing legal verdicts (iftaa) under Mufti Ebrahim Desai. He successfully
